## Eastern Buddhist League 2023 Conference

Join us for our 2023 Eastern Buddhist League (EBL) conference **Saturday, February 11** (10am CST/11am EST/ 8am PST). This half-day event is free and held virtually on Zoom. We will begin with an EBL-wide service and Dharma Talk shared by Rev. Kurt Rye, from Ekoji Buddhist Temple. This will be followed by a presentation with Q&A given by Rev. Dr. David Matsumoto, President of the Institute of Buddhist Studies. The theme of the conference is "Nembutsu as Living," a phrase taken from the book *Heart of the Shin Buddhist Path: A Life of Awakening* by Rev. Dr. Takamaro Shigaraki and translated by Rev. Dr. Matsumoto. Rev. Dr. Shigaraki reminds us that "this path is the nembutsu of everyday life - the nembutsu as living - that Shinran teaches us."

The Eastern Buddhist League consists of Jodo Shinshu Temples and Sanghas in the eastern part of North America. Due to the vast geographical distance between temples, it has been a way to share resources and stay connected. There is no fee for the conference. All are welcome.
